UCI WORLD SERIES LENZERHEIDE (SUI) 2025

Der letzte World Cup in Europa fand in diesem This year's last World Cup in Europe went down in Lenzerheide. The whole event had its own vibe, since Nino Schurter (SUI) had announced it'd be his last World Cup ever. A true legend calling it a day!

On Friday morning, we U23 women had to compete in the XCC. We had to ride 1 start loop plus 8 laps. The start was important so that you wouldn't get stuck in a traffic jam at the first bottleneck. I managed to move up from the 3rd row to 10th position. The first 3 laps went pretty well; I was between 5th and 8th. Suddenly, nothing worked anymore and I fell back to 21st. It took about a lap until I caught myself again and my engine was running. By then, the gaps to the front were already very large. However, I was able to make progress and could catch up on the short technical downhill section and the steep ramps. In the end, it was enough to make it into the top ten.

The XCO course offers a lot of variety between longitudinal, diagonal, and cross roots, with rocks and drops, jumps, and berms. There are just no drops and jumps uphill. The uphill berms are "only" up to 25% steep, after which comes a tarmac climb where I felt like I was stuck. In the first three laps, I was able to hold on to positions 10 to 12. Then I fell back, but was able to settle into 16th position and kept it until the finish.

I am very satisfied with the races this weekend. I was able to achieve my self-set goals. Next week, it's off to North America, where the last two World Cups of the season will take place.
