UCI WORLD SERIES MONT-SAINTE-ANNE (CAN) 2025

The season finale is over. The last World Cup races of this season took place in Mont-Sainte-Anne (CAN) over the weekend. As usual, we started the XCC race early on Friday. The course had no technical challenges; it was "just" very fast. The start was extremely catastrophic. The starting arch did not work, which usually changes from "READY" in red to "GO" in green. There was also no announcement of "the start will take place in 15 seconds." Then there was a whistle, a few started, then a few more, but those in front of me did not. So I eventually came into the first corner as the third last (39th). I kept fighting my way forward until I reached 10th place. However, this cost a lot of energy, and I had to give up some places again. In the end, I finished in 14th place, which meant the second starting row on Sunday.

The XCO course is one of the most technically demanding, as there are also very difficult uphill sections. The rock gardens start with large boulders. The cool thing is that there are often different lines you can take. There are several climbs, most of which are technical, and one goes straight up steeply for a long time. Initially, I was able to stay in the group around the top five, but in the last two laps, I could no longer keep up with the high pace and finished 11th.
